



Pasqua Vigneti e Cantine will also be at the 76th edition of the Mostra Internazionale d'Arte Cinematografica 2019

Two glamorous days in Venice accompanied by quality wine to celebrate cinema in all its forms

Verona, 2 September 2019 – An annual appointment, the Mostra Internazionale d'Arte Cinematografica, organized by the Venice Biennale, started last week. Now in its 76th edition and directed by Alberto Barbera, it will take place as usual at the Lido in Venice. Dates: August 28 to September 7, 2019.

The Venice Film Festival, one of the most important events in the world of cinema, seeks to promote the knowledge and diffusion of international cinema in all its forms of art, entertainment and industry. The first edition took place in 1932, in the Terrace of the Hotel Excelsior del Lido. Today, the Mostra Internazionale d'Arte Cinematografica still represents a fundamental stage for protagonists of the "seventh art". Its charm also lies in the stars, glamour, political messages and the gossip that always surrounds it.

For the first time in Venice on the occasion of the Mostra Internazionale d'Arte Cinematografica, Pasqua Vigneti e Cantine will be there with a series of events starting Monday, 2 September with an exclusive dinner at MET, Michelin-starred restaurant and a dedicated menu created by Chef Luca Veritti for the presentation of the latest from the winery. In particular, there will be a tasting of *Hey French, You Could Have Made This But You Didn't*, a great white wine that purely expresses the vineyards of origin, chosen from their best vintages. Garganega is the prevailing grape, along with Pinot Bianco and Sauvignon, all from the Verona side of Mount Calvarina, located in the easternmost part of the Soave denomination area. This wine is a blend of the best four vintages of the last decade (2013, 2015, 2016, 2017) selected as the maximum expression of the vineyard throughout its history. Tasting will also include some vintages of Famiglia Pasqua and Cecilia Beretta labels, wines created from a selection of crus and with respect for the authentic values of the past.

"We believe in the appreciation of talent and art," commented CEO *Riccardo Pasqua*, "this is why we wanted to celebrate the Mostra del Cinema by organizing some events during this time in the wonderful city of Venice where it will be possible to taste wines that most represent our winery."

The next day, 3 September, a visit organized especially for guests is planned to Le Corderie inside the Biennale Arte.

In the afternoon the group will transfer to the Lido for *Anteprima About Endless* directed by *Roy Andersson*.
